BURGLARY SUSPECTS ARRESTED

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: 2698 E. Hwy 95, All-Star Liquor, Yuma, AZ

YUMA, ARIZONA, MAY 27, 2009: On 5-26-09, at approximately 2148 hours, Deputies of the Yuma County Sheriff's Office responded to the above listed business in reference to a burglary alarm.

When Deputies arrived on scene, they discovered the front glass door to the business had been broken. A review of the security camera tape inside the business showed two suspects had entered the store and stolen beer and other miscellaneous items.

Deputies located shoe impressions belonging to the suspects and tracked them to a residence at 2410 E. 15th Street. Deputies located the two suspects sitting in the front yard of the residence drinking beer. Both suspects were taken into custody.

One suspect, a 15 year old male, was booked into the Juvenile Justice Center on charges of burglary and criminal damage.

The second suspect, 19 year old Patrick Lopez, of Tempe, Az, was booked into the Yuma County Jail on charges of burglary and criminal damage.
