San Luis Police Lieutenant arrested

Location of Incident: San Luis, AZ

On January 5, 2012, the San Luis Police Department requested that the Yuma County Sheriff's Office assist with an investigation into alleged criminal misconduct on the part of a San Luis Police Lieutenant. San Luis Police Administration had learned that a 19 year old female was alleging that Lieutenant Gerardo Torres was stalking her and had detained her against her will during an illegal traffic stop.

The Sheriff's Office conducted an investigation into the allegations of stalking and unlawful imprisonment on the part of San Luis Police Lieutenant Gerardo Torres, 41, of San Luis, AZ. Evidence corroborating the victim's allegations was uncovered during the investigation and Lieutenant Torres was ultimately arrested and booked into the Yuma County Jail on 1/12/2012. Torres was booked on charges of Stalking, Unlawful Imprisonment and Misconduct with Weapons.
