Missing Person

Location of Incident: 17200 block of South Avenue B ½, Somerton, AZ

Update: On Wednesday, June 27, 2018 at approximately 4:45 p.m., the Yuma County Sheriff's Office with the assistance of United States Border Patrol located Ms. Mumma deceased approximately a quarter of a mile away from her home.

Next of Kin has been notified.

Original Release: On Wednesday, June 27, 2018 at approximately 10:00 a.m., the Yuma County Sheriff's Office received a report of a missing person from the 17200 block of South Avenue B ½.

Deputies spoke to the reporting party who stated that the missing person, identified as Lorraine Marie Mumma, 73, of Somerton, was last seen on Monday, June 25, 2018 at her home.

Ms. Mumma is described as 5'03" tall, approximately 115 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes. She was last seen wearing a white shirt, tan pants and a straw hat. Ms. Mumma is unable to verbally communicate due to a medical condition.

Continuous efforts to locate Ms. Mumma by the Sheriff's Office have been unsuccessful.
