



Yuma County Narcotics Task Force 2025 Statistics

During 2025, the Yuma County Narcotics Task Force (YCNTF) took a total of 76 incidents of which 50 were criminal cases, and 15 were search warrants. The YCNTF made a total of 43 arrests during 2025, which consisted of the following:

Drug Related Offenses: 35 Arrests

- **Possession: 20 Arrests**
 - 5 for possession of Fentanyl
 - 9 for possession of Methamphetamine
 - 1 for possession of Drug Paraphernalia
 - 1 for possession of Psilocybin
 - 3 for possession of Cocaine
 - 1 for possession of Weapons

- **Sales/Distribution: 15 Arrests**
 - 3 for sales of Cocaine
 - 4 for sales of Fentanyl
 - 1 for sales of Marijuana
 - 7 for sales of Methamphetamine

Non-Drug Related Offenses: 8 Arrests on Warrants

Breakdown of Total Arrests: 43

- 34 adult males
- 9 adult females

Drug Seizures

Drugs seized by the YCNTF during 2025 had an estimated street value of **\$4,437,177.50** and consisted of the following:

Non-Drug Seizures

In addition to drug seizures, YCNTF officers also seize assets that were either instruments or proceeds of the criminal activity, as well as paraphernalia items. During 2025, YCNTF officers seized:

- \$9,025.25 in U.S. Currency
- 16 Firearms
- 139 miscellaneous drug paraphernalia items
