Missing Person

Location of Incident: 12500 Block of E. 38th Street -Yuma, AZ

UPDATE: Mrs. Finley has been located. The Yuma County Sheriff's Office Search and Rescue Team found her safe and unharmed. She was transported to Yuma Regional Medical Center for medical evaluation.

ORIGINAL RELEASE – January 1, 2023 10:10 PM- On Sunday, January 1, 2023, at approximately 6:16 PM, the Yuma County Sheriff's Office received a report of a missing person.

The missing person, identified as **Margaret Finley**, 81, was last seen at her residence by her husband. She walked out of the home without her cellphone and left on foot in an unknown direction.

Mrs. Finley is described as approximately 5'5" tall, weighing approximately 150 lbs, with gray hair, and brown eyes. She was last seen wearing a black jacket with light colored stripes down the sleeves, dark green pants, and shoes.

Mrs. Finley suffers from Alzheimer's and continuous efforts to locate her by the Yuma County Sheriff's Office have been unsuccessful.
