Attempted Homicide

Location of Incident: 3500 Block of E. Cuadrilla Lane -Yuma, AZ

On Sunday, October 12, 2025, at approximately 6:55 AM, Yuma County Sheriff's Office Deputies responded to the 3500 Block of E. Cuadrilla Lane in reference to a residential trespass in progress.

The suspect, a 17-year-old male, was reported to have entered an occupied family residence, attempting to locate and harm an individual known to him. After being confronted by the homeowner, the suspect exited the residence but remained on the property. Shortly thereafter, the suspect broke a window and reentered the home.

At this time, Deputies arrived, and the suspect attempted to flee at the notice of law enforcement arrival. Deputies deployed non-lethal ammunition, striking the suspect. Deputies detained the suspect and located multiple dangerous instruments on his person intended to be used to cause harm.

The YCSO Criminal Investigation Bureau responded and assumed the investigation.

The suspect was taken into custody and booked into the Yuma County Juvenile Justice Center for multiple charges that include 1st Degree Attempted Homicide, Endangerment and 1st Degree Burglary.

The Yuma County Sheriff's Office would like to extend a commendation to our YCSO Emergency Dispatch personnel that were in communication with the family during the incident and assisted in giving critical direction for safekeeping and quick decision making during a high stress situation. No injuries to victims or law enforcement are reported at this time.
