Level 3 Sex Offender Notification Jose Quintero-Cervantes

New Address: 304 S. May Avenue, #123 – Yuma, AZ 85364

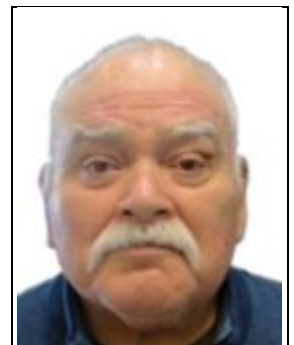
The Yuma County Sheriff's Office (YCSO) is releasing the following information pursuant to A.R.S. 13-3825, the Community Notification on Sex Offenders Law. The offender in this publication is living within Yuma County. It is the responsibility of the Chief Law Enforcement Office having jurisdiction where the offender resides to make notifications to the community. Notification must be made when certain sex offenders are released from the Arizona State Prison, accepted under an interstate compact or released from the county jail back into the community. Offenders are categorized into three levels: Level One (low risk to the community), Level Two (intermediate risk to the community), and Level Three (high risk to the community).

The individual who appears on this notification, **Jose Quintero-Cervantes, 72**, has been convicted of a sex offense that allows for community notification. Jose Quintero-Cervantes has advised the YCSO that he is residing at 304 S. May Avenue, #123 in Yuma, Arizona. He is described as 5 feet 5 inches tall, 220 pounds, with white hair and brown eyes. He is not wanted by the Yuma County Sheriff's Office at this time.

On October 28, 1991, Quintero-Cervantes pleaded no contest and was found guilty of one count of Attempted Molestation of a Child in the Maricopa County Superior Court in Phoenix, Arizona. He was sentenced to serve 1 year in the Maricopa County Jail, followed by lifetime probation. His victim was a female juvenile known to him.

On January 10, 1994, his probation was revoked and he was ordered to serve 10 years in the Arizona Department of Corrections, with credit for 452 days served prior to sentencing.

On June 5, 2025, Quintero-Cervantes pleaded guilty to one count of Attempted Failure to Register as a Sex Offender in the Yuma County Superior Court in Yuma, Arizona. He was sentenced to 36 months of supervised probation.

On October 13, 2025, Quintero-Cervantes pleaded guilty to One Count of Failure to Register as a Sex Offender in the Maricopa County Superior Court in Phoenix, Arizona. He was sentenced to 15 years of supervised probation and is under the supervision of Yuma County Adult Probation.

Jose Quintero is considered a Level 3 sex offender with a high risk to reoffend.

This notification is not intended to increase fear; rather, it is our belief that an informed community is a safer community. The YCSO has no legal authority to direct where a sex offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, this offender is constitutionally free to live wherever he/she chooses. Citizen abuses of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass sex offenders will not be tolerated. Sex Offenders have always lived in our communities; but because of Megan's law, law enforcement is now able to share this information with you.
